**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES NORTH  
ADOPTING THE DOUGLAS COUNTY  
INCIDENT MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES AND STANDARDS**

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish a process and structure for the systematic, coordinated, and effective delivery of public safety services to the community; and

WHEREAS, Douglas County maintains the Douglas County Office of Emergency Preparedness, which is a disaster agency within the meaning of C.R.S. §§ 24-32-2101, *et seq.* and has jurisdiction over and serves the entire County; and

WHEREAS, Douglas County has requested that the City adopt the Douglas County Incident Management Guidelines and Standards (dated Rev. 6-1-04) (the "IMGS") and doing so helps to preserve the public health and safety of the community; and


WHEREAS, the IMGS provides, among other things, that the Douglas County government, cities and towns, and special districts within Douglas County will provide assistance and support to each other, within their ability, and will cooperate to ensure coordinated emergency operations at all times; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates that the City will be included in efforts by the County in connection with the updating of the IMGS.



The City Council hereby adopts the Douglas County Incident Management Guidelines and Standards (dated Rev. 6-1-04).


